New South Wales

As part of its annual Anzac Service, the Emanuel Synagogue will be holding a special tribute to Maj Gen Paul Cullen DSO & Bar ED, prior to its Shabbat Service 6.00pm Friday 21 April 2017. NAJEX Anzac service at the SJM, 9.30 am Sunday 30 April, will highlight the Charge on Beersheba.

Queensland

The CoAJP's four Anzac Centenary Yahrzeit Candles will be taken by Peter Allen to Perth, where he is attending the 2017 Anzac Day services on 25 and 26 April at the Jewish War Memorial in Kings Park and Carmel School, with WAJEX and JCCWA. Having then travelled to all States of Australia for Anzac commemorative services, the candles will ultimately be used in Canberra on 11/11/2018.

ACT

Design has commenced on the third stage of the ACT Jewish Community's plans for a major upgrade to its Canberra centre: an Australian Jewish War Memorial, which is proposed to be unveiled at the Centenary of Armistice Service of the Australian Jewish Community on Sunday 11 November, 2018. On Sunday 30 October 2016, over 100 people filled the delightful Hobart Synagogue, Australia's oldest shul (1845), for the *Anzac Centenary Remembrance Service of the Tasmanian Jewish Community*. A beautiful *'Roll of Honour of the Jewish Community of Tasmania'* was unveiled, made from Tasmanian blackwood and inscribed with the names of 42 Tasmanian Jews who served.
